The Scottish Government has set out a new framework to halt biodiversity loss by 2030 and reverse it with large-scale restoration by 2045. A consultation on this framework, and parts of the National Environment Bill, was launched on 7 September.

The consultation seeks your views on both parts of the framework and is open for 14 weeks **closing in mid-December.**

The £150m Community Ownership Fund (COF) exists to help communities across the UK to take ownership of assets at risk of closure. It will run until March 2025



Scottish Landfill Communities Fund Reopening

The SLCF is a tax credit scheme, linked to Scottish Landfill Tax that encourages landfill site operators to contribute tax credits to benefit community and environmental projects.
