Scotland held a national citizens assembly which considered the framework for a Just Transition.




Our project is focusing on three local authority areas of North East Scotland: Aberdeenshire, Aberdeen City and Moray.

Now we must consider a new transition, away from dependency on fossil fuels, learning how to make changes that protect our environment, resources and climate.




Through communities working in partnership we can share creative better solutions to the climate crisis and increase skills needed in our communities. Our project aims to help communities write a new story of the North East.




OUR STARTING POINT

Primarily we need to move away from our reliance on Oil and Gas. This means reducing energy consumption as well as developing renewable sources of energy.






However, we are relying on government and big business to invest and lead the way on policy to support behaviour change and alternative solutions and technologies.

This became our communities project.


Our project explores how communities can be part of a deliberative process of designing, creating and delivering a "Just Transition"

The local council authorities help us too.










